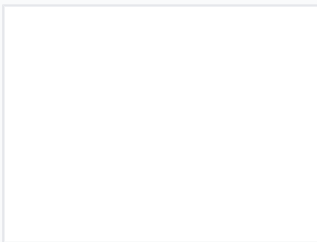


Waste Incineration Power Generation System
